## From the Superintendent.....

I would like to take this opportunity to welcome all of you back for the 2012-13 school year and for those of you that are new to our district we are very pleased to have you with us. We believe you will enjoy your time at Fairfield! I hope you have had an enjoyable summer. This upcoming year, like all others, promises to be both exciting and challenging. As many of you have heard the Ohio Department of Education is changing our required curriculum in all core areas. Throughout the 2011-12 school year we began training staff on the new "Common Core" and the change in state standards. This will require all teachers in Ohio to modify what we teach, how we teach, and how we assess student achievement. The ODE is recommending that we begin implementing the new standards along with the current standards in order to make a smooth transition. Our staff started this process last year. In addition, legislation is proposed that will get back to a 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade Guarantee. We currently do not have all the specifics, but it will require major changes in the identification and intervention of students that are struggling in reading. We also expect that state funding will be flat-lined or possibly reduced for the next budget. This will require us to be even more cognizant of our spending and where the dollars need to go. I am confident that our staff and students will respond and rise to the occasion so that we can continue to be a great school district.

The 2011-12 school year was another great year academically. We have received preliminary testing data and we expect to have an EXCELLENT rating as a district, achieving 25 of 26 report card indicators. Our performance index (an accounting of all tests) is over 100.9 which also ranks us as EXCELLENT. Our Elementary and High School both are currently rated EXCELLENT and the Middle School is ranked EFFECTIVE. The Middle School could still achieve the Excellent rating after Valued Added data is received later in the summer. It is our strong belief that this data will improve their ranking. I want to thank the community for their support of our PI Levy Renewal in March. This will allow us to continue to upgrade technology, the bus fleet, and make other improvements to the buildings and grounds. This levy has been a monumental factor in our ability to keep the district on sound financial ground during these tough economic times. Several of the projects and expenditures will be highlighted throughout the Focus on Fairfield.

I would like to welcome the following new staff members to our district: Mrs. Liza McCoy (HS English), Mrs. Darlyne Crawford (HS Science), Ms. Shannon Abbott (HS Social Studies), Ms. Kay Cummings (Custodial), and Mr. Vincent Burns (Bus Driver). We are happy to have each of you and wish you a very successful school year.

This year as in the past we have applied for Waiver Days for teacher professional development. We have not received confirmation at this time. If we are approved we will adjust our master calendar to reflect these days. The waiver days allow for teachers to continue to get required and necessary training and in-service so they can best meet the needs of our learners.

Please be sure to check the bus routes and schedules in this addition of Focus on Fairfield. Several routes have changed for this school year. Also, a reminder that the 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> Grade students will be on the junior high bell schedule and starting times will change from last year.

As always we look forward to working with your student and hope that their school year will be a great success in many ways. Again, welcome back and feel free to call or stop in the office any time you have a question or concern. Enjoy the last few days of summer break.

# FOOD SERVICE NEWS

## New Food Service Guidelines...Healthier Options

In an effort to provide healthier, more nutritious meals to students, new school meal guidelines put forth by the USDA are in effect this school year:

- A daily serving of fruits
- A daily serving of vegetables plus a weekly requirement for dark green, red/orange, beans/peas, starchy, other veggies
- Increased quantity of combined fruits and vegetables
- Weekly meat/meat alternate ranges plus daily requirement
- Fruits and vegetables are two separate food components
- Student must select at least ½ cup of the fruits or the vegetables component as part of the reimbursable meal
- Half of grains must be whole grain. New daily/weekly ranges.
- Fat-free (unflavored or flavored) and unflavored low-fat milk
- Calorie minimum and maximum levels
- Reduction in sodium allowances
- Limit on trans fat and saturated fat

Fairfield Local Schools is proud to provide a variety of healthy meals and options for our students.

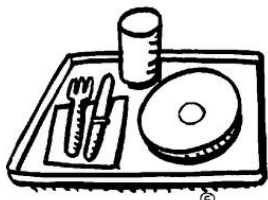

## Elementary Parent Notification

As a recipient of Federal Title 1 funding, Fairfield Elementary School is required to notify parents of elementary students of their right to know about the professional qualifications of our elementary teachers. You have the right to know:

- If the teacher has met state qualifications and licensing criteria for the grade level and subject areas being taught.
- If the teacher is teaching under a temporary or emergency status in which state qualifications or licensing are waived.
- The teacher's baccalaureate degree major, graduate licensure, and field of discipline
- Whether the student is provided services by paraprofessionals, and, if so, their qualifications.

## CHILD FIND

The Fairfield Local School District's adopted Child Find Policy requires that all children below twenty-two (22) years of age residing within the district, who have a disability regardless of the severity of the disability, and who are in need of special education and related services are identified, located, and evaluated in accordance with all federal regulations and state standards.

For children birth through age two, a disability means that a child have a behavior, cognition, communication, physical development, sensory development and/or social or emotional development deficit.

For children age three through five years of age, a disability means that a child has a documented deficit in one or more of the following areas: communication skills, hearing abilities, motor functioning, social emotional/behavior functioning or vision abilities.

For school-age children, a disability means a person having one or more conditions such as autism, developmental handicap, hearing handicap, multi-handicap, orthopedically and/or other health handicaps, emotional/behavior handicap, specific learning disability, traumatic brain injury or vision handicap.

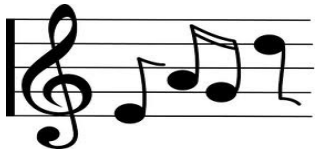

At the bus stop:

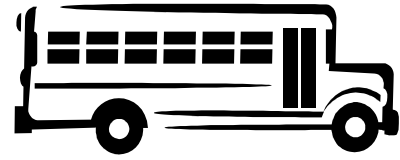
- ◆ Before school - always be on time for the bus. It will not wait for you.

- ◆ No throwing objects in or out of the bus.
- ◆ No bad language.

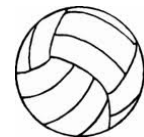

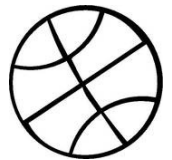
