The Glenn Armstrong Memorial Scholarship was created by Opal Armstrong and her family for Glenn Armstrong who served many years as Math teacher, Driver's Education teacher, Faculty Advisor to the Senior Class, National Honor Society, and the Future Teachers of America at Fairfield Local Schools. A single award of \$1,000 will be made annually to a deserving student.

Eligibility

The scholarship seeks applicants who are seniors at Fairfield High School with plans to obtain a four-year college degree in Education with plans to teach in the K-12 educational system. Applicants must have a 3.25 GPA and show evidence of strong community involvement.

Application

To apply, students should submit a written statement of need to the Guidance Office, explaining how the Scholarship funds will be used. Finalists will be invited for an in-person interview with high school staff as designated by the High School Principal.

Application deadline is April 1, and the funds will be deposited to the District by this date.

The scholarship recipient, family, and District Treasurer will be notified of the award by the Guidance Office in writing.

The scholarship payment will be made by the Treasurer of Fairfield Local School District directly to the student after graduation but prior to August 1 of the award year.
